Training was held in Togo, July 2023 (20 trainees from the laboratory + 15 soil doctors)



B. Soil Doctors

Training held in Nigeria, February 2024 (5 trainers, 50 Soil Doctors, 250 Estimated farmers reached) thanks to the Nigeria Institute of Soil Science in collaboration with Indorama fertilizer

- Topics covered:
 - ✓ Quality control
 - ✓ Chemical and physical soil analysis
 - \checkmark Health and safety in the laboratory

About 80 participants from 40 Sub-Saharan countries attended the training



C. Soil Laboratories...

Towards precise and accurate soil measurements... Follow up actions

- Monitoring the impact of the Dakar training
 - → Survey on the actions taken in the lab on quality assurance and quality control administered
- Facilitating the adoption of GLOSOLAN SOPs
 - → Translation in **French** and **Portuguese**
- Regional inter-laboratory proficiency test (PT) targeting SOC, N, P.
 - ➔ Over 70 African laboratories participated. Results collected, currently under analysis





D. Digital Soil Mapping

85 participants from 22 countries were capacity built on Digital Soil Mapping

E. Connection with other initiatives...



- 7. How to work with farming communities to tackle soil management issues at landscape/watershed level


