- Chaired by Mr. Luca Montanarella (EU)












SUBMISSIONS













- GSERmap Workshop in Yangling (April, 2024): Organized by GSP in collaboration with the World Association of Soil and Water Conservation (WASWAC).
- The GSERmap steering committee agreed to include erosion by water, wind and tillage.
- The final documents will be reviewed by the WG, INSII and ITPS to be endorsed by GSP PA.


