- National Soil Partnerships:
- Ukraine: needs much bilateral support on risk-reduction measures, restoration
 - Ukraine: Rapid Damage and Needs Assessments
 - International Support: (annual) Ukraine Recovery Conference, 11-12 June, Berlin (*lacking action area for agricultural soils*)
 - Example for action at national level:
 - German Ukraine Platform: build partnerships (incl. private sector)
 - Soil: workshops, expert visits, training, on de-mining, damage assessment to
 - soil, restoration, policy development

Overview of existing international guidelines related to sustainable land management (SSM) Pillar 1-Overview of case studies *(to be updated)*

EU research (Horizon Europe Programme with >60 soil-related projects):

- Nature Based Solutions for Soil Management (NBSoil)
- Fostering cross-border knowledge exchange and cocreation on sustainable soil and farm management (Soil-X-Change)
- Other projects relating to agricultural management, e.g. on organic farmland, practices to reduce pesticide risks, climate smart practices, crop resilience, nutrient budgets, etc.

EU Soil Monitoring Law (Proposal 2023): Sustainable soil management principles

EJP Soils partnership: 11 projects supporting SSM

> (Topics e.g. innovative practices, landscape connectivity, compaction, wheat cultivation, grassland management, etc.)



Regional Guideline for SSM: project needed to be established and financed: collection of national site-specific knowledge; aggregation to European level results








Action area 5: Assess, map and monitor soil health

Conclusions 2023/2024

- ESP governance needs update: Pillars-action areas, steering committee, support to NFPs, implementation plan [several aspects of the GSP governance in relation to the Action Framework 2030 are unclear]
- Website needs further partner input: knowledge collection in the ESP requires capacity/position
- Project on Action Area 1: Sustainable Soil Management requires capacity/project
- Focus on subregions (initiatives for new subregions are difficult "top-down"; committed partners and tight cooperation/facilitation are needed)
