## West Africa Soil Doctors Network

- Proposal to USAID for a small-scale 16 month Farmer to Farmer program
- Farmer to Farmer provides US-based technical experts to conduct trainings on agricultural topics of interest to individual countries
- Focused on Sierra Leone, Liberia and Gambia
- Concept:
a. Provide two 2-person teams to conduct two weeks of trainings in each country
b. First team focused on basic soil training, limited advanced training
c. Second team focused on advanced training with some additional basic soil training
d. A train-the-trainer model to help catalyze the country specific Soil Doctor programs
e. Develop relationships between regional Soil Doctors
