#### Action area 1: Sustainable soil management & restoration

- Many information sources exist for a regional guideline/are under development
- Because of the diversity of soil and management conditions, any specific guideline must address application conditions for practices
- Initiatives & information sources: :
  - EIP Agri: Agricultural Knowledge & Innovation Systems (AKIS)
  - EU research projects (EJP Soils and others)
- Towards a European guideline for SSM: capacity needed to
  - to collect and synthesize available knowledge
  - to actively anticipate where knowledge is currently being developed
  - to select and populate a proper information platform





- Focal points need to receive more support/more active involvement

## Conclusions 2022/2023

- Activity hub: ESP regional secretariat needs strengthening (to support subregions, to collect knowledge from the region, subregions and countries)
- Regional cooperation through subregions and national partnerships: regular information exchange needs to be established, however, subregional and national engagement still unsteady as dependent on external funding
