CAADP SLWM Interventions

Activities conducted:

- SLWM programmes in 9 COMESA countries being implemented through the NAIPs
- Conservation Smart Agriculture-1.2 million farmers
- Training on Management of land and groundwater resources for improved agricultural productivity
- M&E System for harmonization and aggregation of SLWM indicators...now CAADP Results Framework
- Regional Communication Strategy incl SLWM
- Networking on water resource management

CAADP

FAO-COMESA PROJECT TCP/INT 3404

- Support to the pre- and post-CAADP compact process for improved agricultural water management (Pillar 1)
- CAADP's Pillar 1 aims to extend the area under sustainable land and water management in Africa
- All countries in this project except Malawi do not meet the CAADP target of 6% annual agricultural GDP growth
- All countries in this project except Malawi do not meet the CAADP target of 10% annual national budget to agriculture

Outcomes

- Improved AWM in Swaziland, Malawi, Sudan and Egypt: Swaziland and Sudan have completed NAIPs in project period
- Swaziland: NAIP 3.3 m Euros (Nat Resource Mgt-Business Meeting Next
- Malawi: NAIP 583m USD (Sustainable Agricultural Water Management)
- Sudan: NAIP 2048 m USD (Protection of Ag Land, Modernization of Ag, Enabling Envt)-BM nxt
- Egypt: Investment priority profile for AWM built

Outcomes Cont'd

- Network and partnerships cemented on AWM priorities in project countries
- Increased regional integration and coordination between COMESA and AgWA

Activities 2014-15

- Development of Institutional and Policy Analyses for all countries
- Development of National Investment Profiles for all countries
- •Consultation workshops in Malawi and Swaziland to identify key investment areas
- •In-country training workshops in all countries on evidence-based analysis tools
- •National level **policy dialogues** in Egypt, Sudan and Swaziland to endorse **project results**
- •Donor's roundtables in Malawi and Swaziland to promote external investment in AWM
- •COMESA-AgWA roundtable concerning policy, strategy and lines of interventions
