Because of the important posts he has occupied, Mr BEN OSMAN has had close contacts with the Organization ever since 1957. During this period of 30 years he has participated in a dynamic way in many of the Organization's activities. In particular, he:

- He has participated in negotiations connected with his activities with international and regional institutions and in the context of Tunisia's bilateral relations with various countries
- He has always been an active member of the Parti Socialiste Destourien (PSD) (Destour Socialist Party) and is now on the Party's Central Committee.

Mr BEN OSMAN holds the Grand Cordon de la République, the Ordre de l'Indépendance and the Ordre du Mérite de Bourguiba (May 1987), awarded him by the President of the Republic of Tunisia, Habib Bourguiba, in recognition of his important services to his country. He also holds a number of decorations from foreign countries.
