	For the management of unsupported compounds, the EWG should:
	 (i) further examine amitraz, dinocap/meptyldinocap, methamidophos/acephate, bitertanol, fenthion, and parathion-methyl according to the Management Approach for Unsupported Compounds without Public Health Concern Scheduled for Periodic Review for internal use by CCPR; and
	(ii) coordinate with EWG Chair on Priorities in accordance with the management approach; and
Description of work	(iii) present the results for consideration by CCPR56 based on points (i-ii).
	For the national registration database, the EWG should:
	 (i) continue developing the NRD with compounds that will go to Table 2B (compounds that have been evaluated 15 years ago or more but have not yet been scheduled or listed for periodic review) of the priority list each year; and
	(ii) consider the compounds listed in Group 3 (compounds that in 2023 reached 15 - 19 years since their last periodic review) to seek support for their periodic review.
Timetable for work	The summary key points of discussion and the proposals for consideration by CCPR56 should be submitted to the Codex Secretariat for distribution and consideration by CCPR56 (2025) not later than 10 March 2025
