

Win-win outcomes of adaptation and mitigation

- Not hold poor farmers accountable for GHG emissions from agricultural lands
- Critical examination of instruments for payment of environmental services that directly or indirectly lead to greater food security, including exploration of novel means by which farmers might benefit (climate-friendly certification, conservation agriculture)
- Farm-based evaluations of the mitigation potential of different practices and technologies

Enabling Adaptation

- Understand the institutional and information needs to aid farmers to switch to most adapted varieties, and in extreme cases to new crops
- Invest in information systems for monitoring changes occurring in the climate, the impacts these have on varietal and crop selection, and check for sustainability in medium-long term of these changes
