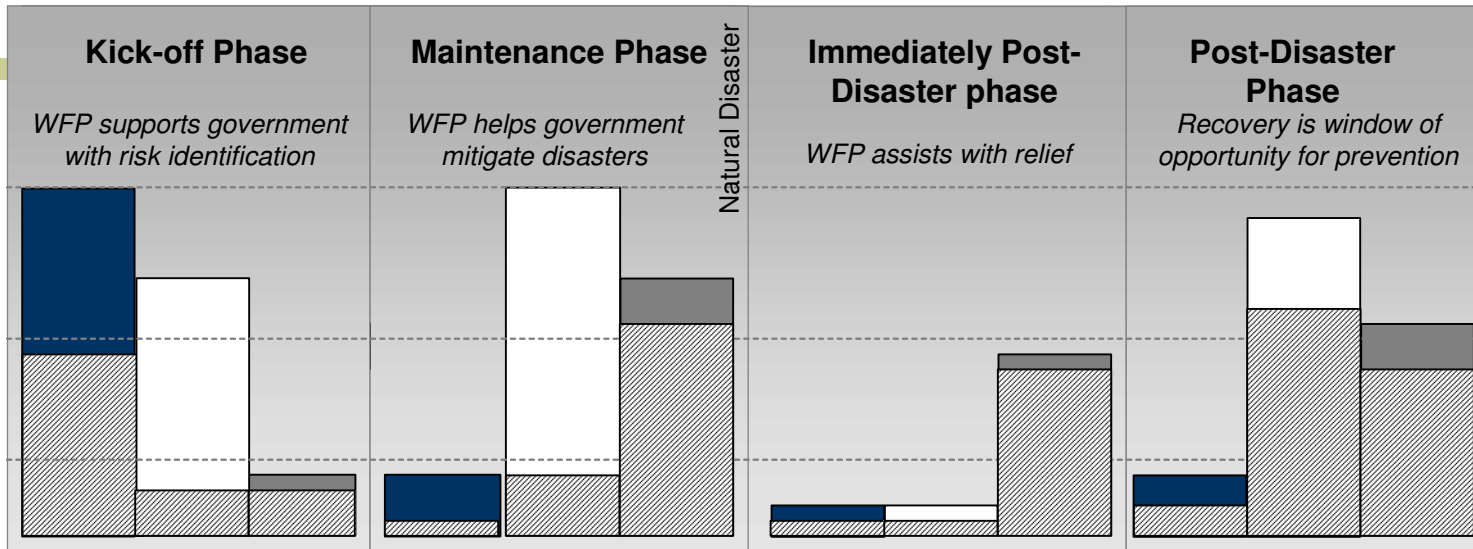

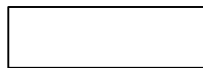

 Socio-economic prevention

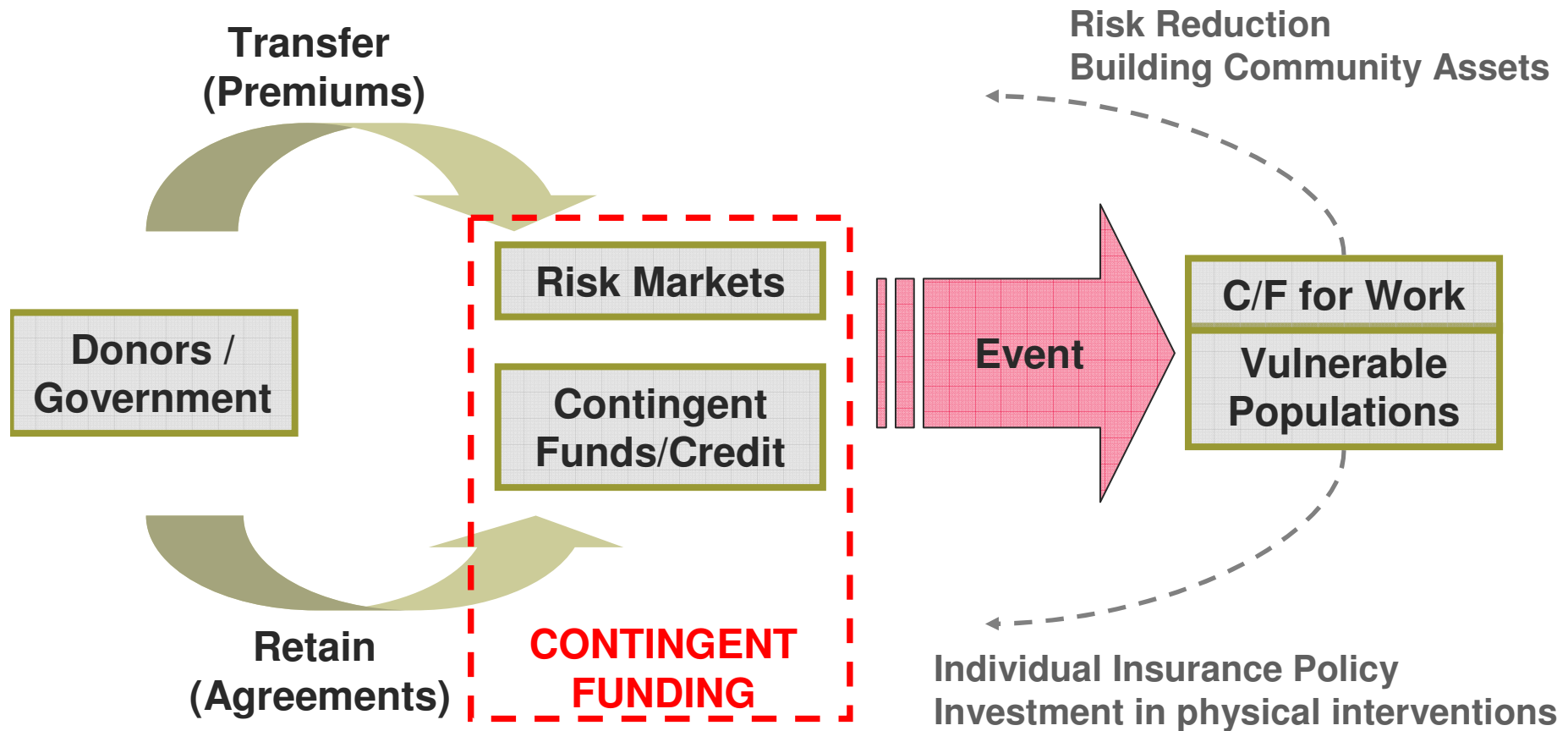
Priority entry points for WFP into DRR
