WHAT IS IT?

It is a global initiative co-led by the Government of Italy and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and launched in May 2022. It is developed with young people, youth constituencies, and strategic partners around three core pillars, aiming to address climate change challenges and empower youth-led climate action:

- Build on the lessons learned and recommendations from the 2021 <u>Youth4Climate Manifesto</u> and previous events.
- Boost youth-led and youth-inclusive climate action on the ground, by strengthening the identification of and supporting concrete and innovative youth-led solutions and ideas.
- Sustain meaningful and long-term engagement with and for youth, by making possible the generation and exchange of knowledge, opportunities, experiences, and resources in a new global <u>virtual space</u>.



COMPONENT 1

Youth4Climate Flagship Event

The annual Youth4Climate flagship is dedicated to enhancing the results achieved by the initiative, focusing on youth-led climate action and the implementation of solutions.

In 2022, the event was held in New York at the margins of the 77° United Nations General Assembly.

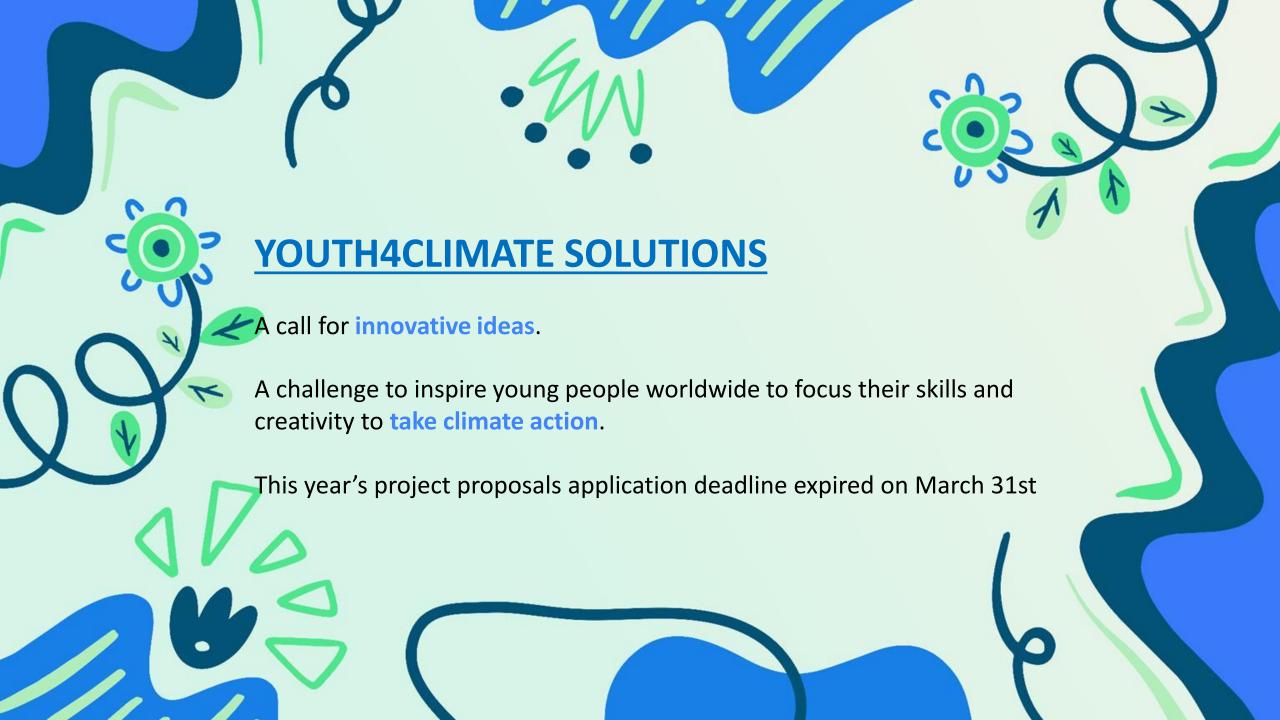


COMPONENT 3

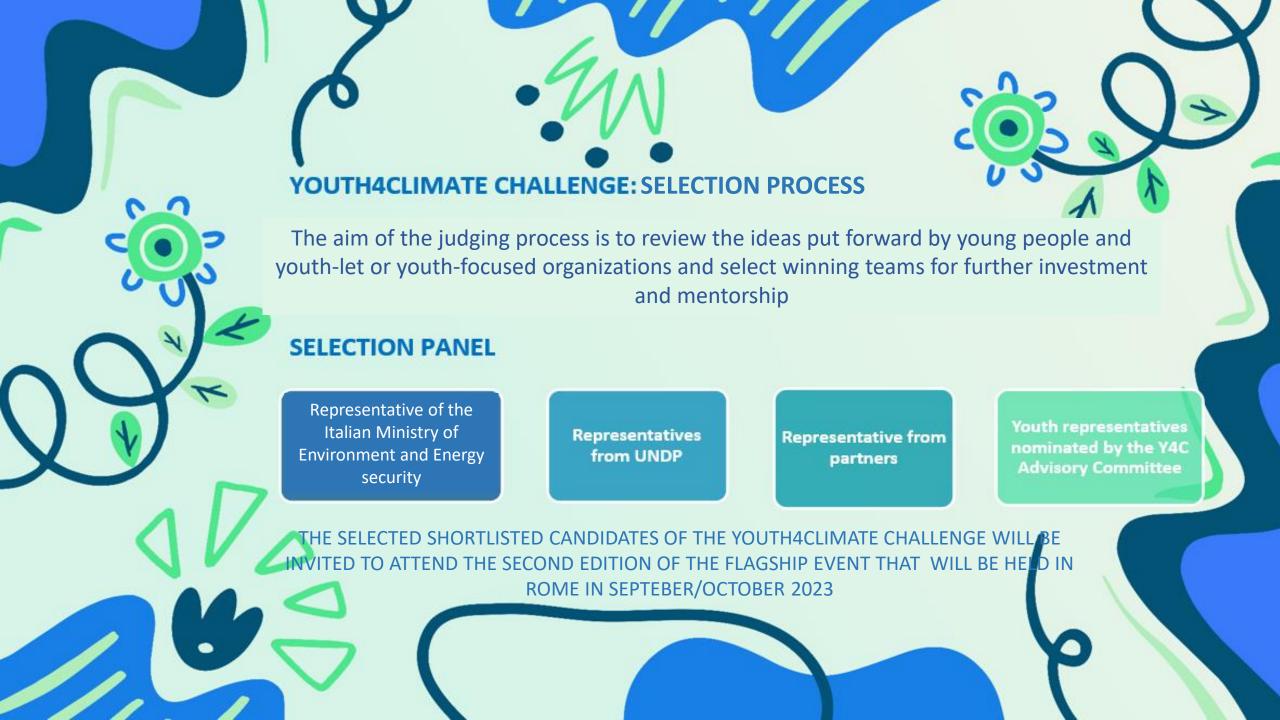

Proposed Work Plan and approach

 Logical and structured scope of work with clearly defined, context specific and innovative deliverables and realistic timelines.



Degree of Innovation

 Development of a completely new idea and/or is a new approach within the local context.



Replicability and scalability

• Easily replicable or scalable



Project cost feasibility

•Types of expenses and their amounts fully meet the needs of the project implementation.



Impacts on the environment

 Address particular environmental and climate challenges and clearly articulates the potential for impact.



Impact on the community

 Address relevant challenges and has a structured plan to create positive changes in the lives of communities.



Potential for gender equality

•Create the potential/likelihood to contribute to gender equality and gender mainstreaming.
