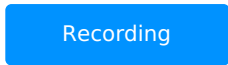


GACSA Highlights: September - October 2022



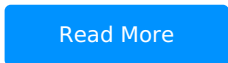
Empowering young women farmers focused on Climate Smart Agriculture

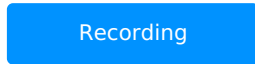
Biennial Africa Climate Smart Agriculture Stakeholders Conference

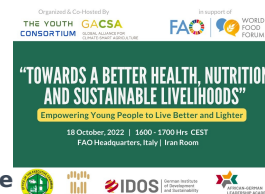
GACSA and Action Groups. GET INVOLVED
