The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) announced the new Project to Strengthen Resilience of Rural Communities to Food and Nutrition Insecurity (PRECIS) that will boost support for about 210,000 poor rural households in Niger that are vulnerable to climate shocks and food insecurity. In Niger, most people live in rural areas and depend on small scale family farming and livestock production for their subsistence, improving small-scale agricultural production and productivity so that farmers can move from subsistence to commercialization is vital to reducing poverty and improving food and nutrition security in rural areas.
