Information was shared on establishing safeguards for responsible investment as well as potential gaps and risks, and recommendations for establishing an enabling policy environment for private investment.

#### CGAIR - Research Program on Climate Change, Agriculture and Food Security (CCAFS): A roadmap for gender equality in agriculture in Central America

Climate-Smart Agriculture (CSA) is an approach that can promote gender equality and women's empowerment in agriculture. It does so by taking into account the priorities and capacities of women and men when they adopt CSA practices. Combined, different CSA practices can benefit women in a specific context. Researchers must identify which practices have proved to advance the transformation of agriculture and rural development in a way that promotes gender equality.

The FAO Office of Climate Change, Biodiversity and Environment is developing a survey-based M&E tool to assess farm sustainability in the context of CSA projects. The tool will help identify interventions and practices that can support farmers transition toward more sustainable production systems. The initiative is part of the project Sustainable productivity in agriculture, funded through FAO's Flexible Multi-partn Mechanism (FMM).
