# INTERNATIONAL MOUNTAIN DAY CELEBRATIONS

Mountain Partnership members across the globe came out in force on 11 December to celebrate International Mountain Day 2013 (IMD). An impressive array of events and initiatives -- from children's art competitions to conferences, festivals, round tables, public video messages, reforestation activities, photographic exhibitions, TV panels and a handicraft exhibition -- helped raise awareness of the importance of sustainable mountain development across every continent.

# Municipality of Dénia (Spain) - Ccorca (Peru)

As a result of the interaction between the Municipality of Denia and Consortium for Sustainable Development of the Andean Ecoregion (CONDESAN) at the Fourth Global Meeting of the Mountain Partnership in Erzurum, Turkey, the two Mountain Partnership members organized a twin celebration of IMD with an awareness-raising focus involving school children from the two regions. # Altai Republic of the Russian Federation

The Interregional Conference "Mountains - Key to Sustainable Future", held on 11 December in the Altai Republic of the Russian Federation, was co-organized by the Government and the MP member "Foundation for Sustainable Development of Altai" (FSDA). Alexandr Alchubaev, Minister of Economic Development and Investments of the Altai Republic, discussed the national, regional and local programmes related to SMD. The representatives of Bourges Nature Park from France and the Altai Ministry of Tourism and Entrepreneurship suggested the creation of the first Geopark in the Altai Republic and Russia. # Kyrgyzstan

IMD observance in Kyrgyzstan was committed to exploring an in-country process for joining the SDGs reinstating the MDGs. A panel discussion was organized by MP member Rural Development Fund, under the support of the MP Central Asia Hub at MSRI/UCA. Participants discussed the country's progress on sustainability and integrating mountains into the development processes with five guest panelists representing different backgrounds - farming, research, NGO, environment and education. ## China

In order to celebrate IMD, the secretariat of CNICIMOD and Yangtze River Research Branch of GSC jointly organized a workshop in Chengdu, Sichuan province, China on 10 - 14 December, 2013. The event was also an opportunity to create a platform for exchanging knowledge on mountain development in the Yangtze River basin and summarize the work of CNICIMOD. #### India

CEE Himalaya celebrated IMD 2013 with students and teachers in Uttarkashi, a small Himalayan town. More than 500 students and 32 teachers from 17 schools along with 46 other participants gathered at a local school to celebrate the day. Children were provided with the message that mountains can be preserved through enhancing green cover, taking care of water sources and rivers, valuing local plants, food and culture which is unique and sustainable. Some of the activities in which the students participated enthusiastically were storytelling, slogan writing, group discussion, chart making as well as a quiz structured around the theme of IMD 2013. ## Innsbruck

"Crossing borders and pushing limits" was the theme chosen by the Permanent Secretariat of the Alpine Convention for an event organized at the Alpenverein-Museum in Hofburg, Innsbruck. Vanessa Francois, who became a paraplegic after a mountain accident, talked about how she managed, just three years after her accident, to climb a big wall at El Capitan, Yosemite National Park using only her arms. ### Vienna

# Algeria

The second Mountain festival, a weeklong of celebrations, organized by the Association Assirem Gouraya and Forest Conservation Bejawas held in Tizi N'Berber, a town in northern Algeria. The festival, aimed to raise awareness among local and national authorities about the need to protect mountain environments, develop sustainable mountain tourism, educate students to reforestation practices and create sustainable employment by training local mountain guides. ## Iran

The conference "The Rights and Policies for Mountains" was held by the Mountain Environment Protection Society (MEPS) in Tehran on 16 December 2013 to celebrate IMD and the 20th anniversary of MEPS. Several high ranking officials, Parliament members, academia, mountain environment experts, NGO representatives and mountain lovers attended the conference including key speaker Prof. Bruno Messerli, Former Director of Institute of Geography, University of Bern, Switzerland. At the end of the conference a "Mountain Declaration" was issued with suggestions for the creation of mountain legal structure in Iran. Read more

# **Andean Region**

To commemorate IMD in the Republic of Guinea, the mountain team of the Ministry of Environment, Water and Forests and the Focal Point of the Mountain Partnership held a roundtable with civil society on Wednesday 11 December 2013 in Conakry under the theme: "Mountains, key to a sustainable future." Emphasis was placed on the importance of mountain ecosystems for the survival of man on the planet and involvement of mountain municipalities, civil society and the private sector. A schedule of meetings with stakeholders will be established during the year 2014 and will be completed by the establishment of a National Committee for the Sustainable Development of Mountains of the Republic of Guinea. # Kenya

The Climate Change Impacts on Ecosystem Services and Food Security in Eastern Africa (CHIESA)Project celebrated IMD with an exhibition of artwork by students who took part in an art competition aptly themed 'My Mountain, My Home'. The competition inspired 269 submissions of artwork from 10 primary and secondary schools in Taita Hills, Kenya and Kilimanjaro, Tanzania, from which 35 drawings were chosen as winning entries. Out of the remaining pool of art, a further three drawings from each school will be selected for auction at the International Centre of Insect Physiology and Ecology (ICIPE) Kenya in February 2014, and proceeds used to purchase indigenous tree saplings for planting at participating schools. #### Madagascar

Madagascar celebrated its first IMD with the support of FAO Madagascar. The Prime Minister and the Interim Minister of Environment and Forests delivered key messages to the national media as well as spot on mountains in Malagasy. The 15 minutes spot was produced in collaboration with the "Association de la Population de Montagne à Madagascar" and focuses on good practices in mountain areas. Read more



# Uganda

Uganda joined the global community to celebrate IMD with an event organized by the Ministry of Water and Environment, in partnership with the District Local governments that make up the Mount Elgon Ecosystem, FAO, and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). The Chief Guest at the occasion was Honourable Flavia Nabugere Munaaba, Minister of State for Environment, representing the Minister of Water and Environment. In her speech, the Minister emphasized Uganda's commitment to addressing problems of hilly and mountainous areas in the country, to ensure sustainability of the resources for the present and future generations. The FAO Representative, Alhaji M. Jallow, used the occasion to remind participants of the challenges faced by mountain people. The day event was concluded with a panel discussion at the Uganda Broadcasting Corporation (UBC) Television Network, which highlighted the challenges, opportunities and solutions for the Mountain areas.
