

Outbreaks and control measures

- 02/10/2014 Lumpy skin disease
 - Reoccurrence of disease
 - 14 outbreaks
 - Resolved on 25/11/2014
 - Impact 33 deaths out of 2822 cases
- 07/07/2014 Lumpy skin disease
 - First occurrence of disease
 - 2 outbreaks
 - Resolved on 04/09/2014
 - Impact 14 cases no losses
- Control measures during both outbreaks
 - Movement restriction
 - Quarantine
 - Vector control
