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1. Benefit of CSC in National GHG Inventories-Cambodia

- To have baseline data of CSC for time series monitoring
- To attract support(financial, technical) from donors
- Can know the impact and provide a suitable solution.
- To meet Paris Agreement target
- Support Cambodia's climate change ambition.
- To reduce GHGs emission

2. Main Challenges starting reporting using IPCC tier 1

- Lack of human resource and staff turnover
- Coordination among institutions is limited
- Limit capacity to apply the methodology
- Land use change data is not compiled within the country (MoE and MAFF (GDA-Forestry Administration))
- Financial support
- Lack of information support to policy maker

3. What is the immediate next step?

- Participation and engagement from high-level policy maker
- Capacity building for relevant institutions
- Mainstream CSC to GHGs emission target in the Agriculture sector
- Raise CSC into planning
