

FIRMS is an information sharing partnership to facilitate the monitoring of stocks status and fisheries among 14 intergovernmental organizations / 19 RFBs





About FIRMS (1)

- Provide access to a wide range of high-quality information on the global monitoring and management of fishery marine resources.
- Monitoring based on inventories of stocks and fisheries



Each stock inventoried include information on the identification of single marine resources/stocks plus the indicators of Stock State and total catch (or landings) http://firms.fao.org/firms/stocks-fisheries-map-viewer

About FIRMS (2)

Benefits

- Dissemination easy access to high quality information for the development/enhancement of fisheries policies and management plans at national and regional levels
 - Functional for **Decision Support System** or other policy frameworks
- First level **information sharing** in the Caribbean helping to structure a stepwise approach towards statistics data sharing
- Tracking history of fishery/stocks status to provide trends perspectives

FIRMS Marine Resource & Fishery inventories

- * Inventories constitute the **backbone** of the FIRMS knowledge base. Inventories provide the complete picture from which to **assess** current level of knowledge
- * Marine Resources and Fisheries are inventoried for reporting purpose
- * To capture **status** and **trends** of Marine Resources and Fisheries
- The inventory is implemented using an Excel format for initial data input
- Once harmonized according FIRMS standards and validated by data owners, information is stored into the FIRMS database and published as fact sheets
- * Through their data inputs in FIRMS, partners contribute to the **global inventory** of marine resources and fisheries.



FIRMS Marine Resource inventory

Marine Resource inventory: a comprehensive list of aquatic resources of value to fisheries.

The aquatic resources are the biotic element of the aquatic ecosystem, including genetic resources, organisms or parts thereof, populations, etc. with actual or potential use or value (sensu lato) for humanity.




FIRMS Fishery inventory

FISHERY: "A Fishery is an activity leading to the harvesting of fish, within the boundaries of a defined area. The fishery concept fundamentally gathers indication of human fishing activity, including from economic, management, biological/environmental and technological viewpoints (FIRMS 2006, modified from FAO glossary of fisheries)".

A statistical **fishing unit** is a particular type of fishing activity, conducted by a single flag country using a vessel and its major fishing gear.

Key data for fishery unit identification:

- Species (target and bycatch)
- Fishing area
- Gear
- Flag state
- Management entities






Status of the FIRMS Data coverage

Marine Resources and Fisheries

- FIRMS database currently covers:
 - shared stocks under RFBs mandates
 but also
 - national stocks / assessment units
 - status of national fisheries

Under RFBs monitoring capacity

- Published inventory of 1479 stocks and 738 fisheries
- Published status reports for about
 600 stocks
 and 250 fisheries
- → about 2 third of identified records with no published status






