Background

- FAO's objective is to strengthen regional collaboration on forests and climate change actions.
- AWG/LCA in it's report to the CoP (FCCC/CP/2010/7)
 Invites Parties to strengthen and, where necessary,
 establish regional centres and networks to
 facilitate and enhance national and regional adaptation
 actions
- FAO prepared regional analyses on forests and climate change in 3 regions



Objectives of workshop

- take stock of national efforts on climate change adaptation
- identify key sub-regional cooperative actions that would enhance national efforts on forests and climate change adaptation
- identify priorities for national and sub-regional action on forests, rangelands and climate change adaptation
- assess country's interest in strengthened regional and/or sub-regional cooperation
- develop logical frameworks for sub-regional projects
- discuss possible funding sources for forests,
 rangelands and climate change adaptation projects

Expected outcomes

- general awareness about climate change enhanced amongst countries
- national and sub-regional forests and climate change priorities identified
- logical frameworks developed for sub-regional projects developed
