






#### Forest and forest land in Croatia


## Croatian response to Climate Change

#### **Mitigation measures**

- Promoting SFM
- Enhancement of Carbon stock (reforestation, afforestation, rural areas and settlements covered with trees)
- Control of fires, pests, diseases...
- Wood energy policy/Wood product use/objectives of renewable energy use till 2020:
  - -RES in final energy consumption 20%
  - -RES of biofuels in transport 10%
  - -RES in electrical energy production 35%
  - -increasment from 15 to 26 PJ of energy consumption from biomass
  - -development of wood industry and exploitation of biomass in sustainabale way

#### **Adaptation measures**

- In progress...
- Reducing vulnerability to maintain forest functions through SFM
- Minimizing the risk of disturbances (fires, floods, erosions, lendslides...)
