### MEMBERSHIP OF THE WFP EXECUTIVE BOARD

1. In accordance with Resolution 6/99 adopted by the 30<sup>th</sup> Session of the FAO Conference on 13 November 1999, the Council is required to elect six members of the WFP Executive Board for a term of office of three years from among FAO Member Nations.
2. For purposes of election to the Board, FAO Member Nations are divided into five separate lists (A, B, C, D and E) as shown on the FAO Council Web page under "Other Documents": [http://www.fao.org/unfao/bodies/council/cl138/Index\\_en.htm](http://www.fao.org/unfao/bodies/council/cl138/Index_en.htm)
3. The Council will therefore be required to elect six members for a term of office expiring on 31 December 2012 to replace the ones whose terms end on 31 December 2009, i.e. Zambia (List A); Pakistan and Philippines (List B); Peru (List C); Netherlands and United States of America (List D)
4. Outgoing members are eligible for re-election.
5. A nomination form is given in the Appendix. The deadline for submission of nominations to the Secretary-General of the Conference and Council is **12.00 hours on Friday 20 November 2009**.
